

## **SUMMARY ANNUAL REPORT**

### **For Eden II School for Autistic Children Life Plan**

This is a summary of the annual report of the Eden II School for Autistic Children Life Plan, EIN 13-2872916, Plan 502, for period May 01, 2010 through April 30, 2011. The annual report has been filed with the Employee Benefits Security Administration, U.S. Department of Labor, as required under the Employee Retirement Income Security Act of 1974 (ERISA).

#### **Insurance Information**

The plan has a contract with the Standard Life Insurance Company of New York to pay certain benefit claims incurred under the terms of the plan. The total premiums paid for the plan year ending April 30, 2011 were \$19,742.

Because it is a so called “experience-rated” contract, the premium costs are affected by, among other things, the number and size of claims. Of the total insurance premiums paid for the plan year ending April 30, 2011, the premiums paid under such “experience-rated” contract were \$19,742 and the total of all benefit claims paid under the contract during the plan year was \$55,398.
